

ZOC FUN DAY SPRINT SERIES

RULES AND REGULATIONS

These rules apply to the Zwartkops Owners Club Fun Day events as listed on the ZOC Calendar. Supplementary regulations will be issued for each event and will compliment these Rules and Regulations.

1 The following details will be contained in the Supplementary Regulations:

2. DATE :

3. TITLE AND TYPE OF COMPETITION:

This CLUB event will be called the and will count towards the ZOC Victor Ludorum.

5. DESCRIPTION OF THE EVENT:

The event will consist of a minimum of three timed runs on a pre-determined course as set out by the Organisers. The course will be on tar with a length of between 1 and 3 kilometers, and the competition will be open to cars according to the classes set out below.

6. VENUE: Zwartkops Complex

7. ENTRIES:

Entries open as soon as the event is announced, and will be accepted until the start of the event. They may be made online at www.zoc.co.za or by handing in the entry form to the race Office at Zwartkops Raceway. The organisers reserve the right to limit the number of entries or to refuse any entry. A car may have a maximum of two drivers. Every entrant must sign an Indemnity Form which will indemnify the Organisers from any claim.

8. ENTRY FEES:

The entry fee will be R150. for ZOC members and R200 for non members. Paid up members are required to show their membership card at Documentation. All cheques, postal orders, etc. to be crossed and made payable to Zwartkops Owners Club ABSA Edenvale Branch 630-642 Account 4053016258

9. STARTING ORDER:

The starting order will be numerically by Class. Each competitor will be allocated a competition number which must be displayed on the windscreen of his car.

10 The best time out of the first three timed runs will be scored and will count towards the Overall results.

11. POSTPONEMENT, ABANDONMENT OR CANCELLATION:

In the event being cancelled another date may be allocated. Entry fees will not be refunded.

12. CLASSES:

Class A: Cars with an Engine capacity up to and including 1440cc
Class B: Cars with an Engine capacity 1441 to and including 1650cc
Class C: Cars with an Engine capacity 1651 to and including 2050cc
Class D: Cars with an Engine capacity 2051 to and including 3000cc
Class E: Cars with an Engine capacity 3001 and more (open)
Class S: Single seaters, including Karts
Class E: Juniors: Under the age of 15 years old.
Class L: Ladies.

Class rating of turbo or supercharged engines: normal capacity X 1.4

Class rating of engines with more than three valves per cylinder: normal capacity X 1.2

Class rating of Rotary Engine: The difference between the max and min capacity of the Combustion chamber X 2.

Example: 16 valve 1600 fitted with turbo: $1600 \times 1.2 \times 1.4 = 2688\text{cc}$ Class rating of Rotary Engine: The difference between the max and min capacity of the Combustion chamber X 2. Example: 16 valve 1600 fitted with turbo: $1600 \times 1.2 \times 1.4 = 2688\text{cc}$

13. SCRUTINY:
All cars must be presented for scrutiny at least 20 min. before their start time. Any vehicle considered by the Scrutineers to be unsafe will not be allowed to start. The following will be checked in particular:
14. PRE-START REQUIREMENTS:
Entry fee paid, completed entry form, signed indemnity, scrutineering mark.
15. THE ROUTE:
The route will be marked by the Organisers using arrows, pylons and/or bunting.
16. CONTROLS AND PROCEDURE AT CONTROLS:
At the start: A control identified by a control board. Competitors must start astride the start line.
At the stop: A control board with the word STOP indicating the competitor must stop astride the stop line.
17. SCORING:
Competitors' times for each of the timed runs will be recorded. The fastest time recorded by a competitor will count for the final results.
18. PRIZES AND AWARDS:
Best time of the day - The ZOC Floating Trophy.
Trophies may be presented to Class winners.
19. PRIZE GIVING AND RESULTS:
Results will become announced 30 minutes after the finish of the event. Prize giving will be held thereafter.
20. PENALTIES:
 - a) Jumping the start - 10 second penalty
 - b) Not stopping astride the stop line – 10 second penalty.
 - c) Deviation from the route - exclusion
 - d) Vehicle not complying with Class requirements - exclusion
 - e) Dangerous and/or unsporting behavior - exclusion
 - f) Practicing reported to organizers during preceding month - not allowed to compete.
 - g) Any Driver found to have entered in the wrong Class will forfeit his/her points in the Series and be banned from entering the next three events.
21. TIMETABLE:
Documentation and Scrutiny will take place at 08:00. A Drivers Briefing will take place at 08:45 and the event will start at 09:00.
22. GENERAL:
 - 22.1 At all times while on the course, drivers must have safety belts & crash helmets securely fastened.
